Credit Report and Financial Status

Rule 4-708 indicates that one of the factors the Character and Fitness Committee considers during its review of an application is the applicant's financial status. Specifically, whether the applicant has outstanding debt in default or collections or more than 60 days past due.

Each applicant is required to upload a credit report from Experian, dated within 30 days of the date the applicant submits the application. **The applicant can access a free credit report here:** [Experian Credit Report](#)

If the applicant has outstanding debt in default, collections, or more than 60 days past due, the Office of Admissions will hold the application until the applicant demonstrates they have completed six months of payments under a payment plan with the collector or creditor. Documentation should be uploaded to the applicant's admissions account.

Pursuant to Rule 4-707(g), the Office of Admissions will close your application if you have not remedied all deficiencies, including financial deficiencies, within one year of submitting your application.
